2013-14 Transportation Delays Due To Hazardous Weather

Dear Parents:

Winter is quickly approaching which often brings inclement weather and the possibility of hazardous road conditions for buses. There are certain locations within the district that become difficult to travel when weather becomes inclement.

In the event that we experience such conditions, and deem it safest to run buses on snow routes, the following roads will not be traveled. A snow route stop has been listed below for each road that will not be traveled:

Allen Rd	Rte. 4 pick-up and drop off on Middle Fork Rd	7:40 & 4:20
August Road	Rte. 1 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 Includes: Four Seasons , Highland Rd, Summer Run Dr and Starlight Dr.	6:35 & 3:50
Clark Road	Rte. 2 pick-up and drop off on Gish Rd Includes Ricky Lane	7:40 & 3:45
Guerrier Road	Rte. 4 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 Includes: Moseley Rd and Briar Rose Lane	6:45 & 3:50
Hyak Road	Rte. 4 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 Includes: Hilltop View Rd and Sunrise Dr	6:40 & 3:45
Oppelt Road	Rte. 3 pick-up and drop off on Centralia Alpha Rd	7:30 & 4:20
Short Road	Rte. 1 pick-up and drop off on Centralia Alpha Rd	6:45 & 4:15
Stub Road	Rte. 1 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508 Includes: Hockett Rd	6:30 & 4:00
Studhalter Road	Rte. 1 pick-up and drop off on St. Rte. 508	6:50 & 4:50
Tillie Road	Rte. 6 pick-up and drop off on Burnt Ridge Includes: Michael Ln	7:30 & 4:25
Walhaupt Road	Rte. 2 pick-up and drop off on Leonard Rd	7:30 & 3:45
Wirsdorfer Road	Rte. 3 pick-up and drop off on Centralia Alpha Rd	7:00 & 3:40

Students on the specified roads will be picked up in the morning and dropped off in the afternoon at the alternate bus stop (indicated on the map by a star symbol) each day snow routes are in effect. **Please note:** Times are approximate. Actual times will fluctuate due to overall road and weather conditions. An automatic phone alert will be sent out each morning buses will be traveling on snow routes. Please make sure you have a current phone number listed with your child/children's school office. The notice will also be reported to the following media networks: **KOMO** – Channel 4 news; **KING** – Channel 5 news; **KIRO** – Channel 7 news; **KCPQ** – **Q13FOX** – Channel 13 news; **KELA** -1470 AM radio; **KITI** – 1420 AM and live 95.1 FM radio; **KMNT** – 104.3 FM radio; **KXXO** – Mixx 96.1 FM radio.

A map has been attached to help identify the roads that will **not** be traveled by buses when snow routes are in effect.
